


Jobs (Millions) Seasonally Adjusted








U.S. Leisure & Hospitality Jobs





Sales Trailing 12 Months




Dallas-Plano-Irving Home Sales & Median Prices

Sales Trailing 12 Months







Household Debt Service as a Percent of Household Disposable Income




U.S. Real Retail & Food Service Sales

\$ Billions – Seasonally Adjusted






Federal Debt – Total Public Debt




Federal Debt Interest Payments In March 2017 30% Greater Than March 2016

U.S. Commercial Real Estate Sales Volume






Dallas Commercial Real Estate Sales Volume








