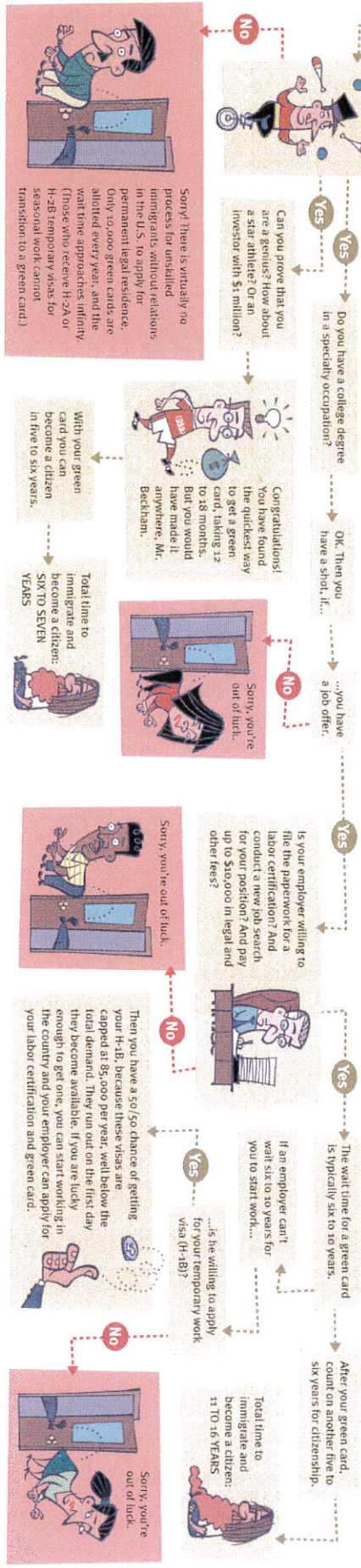
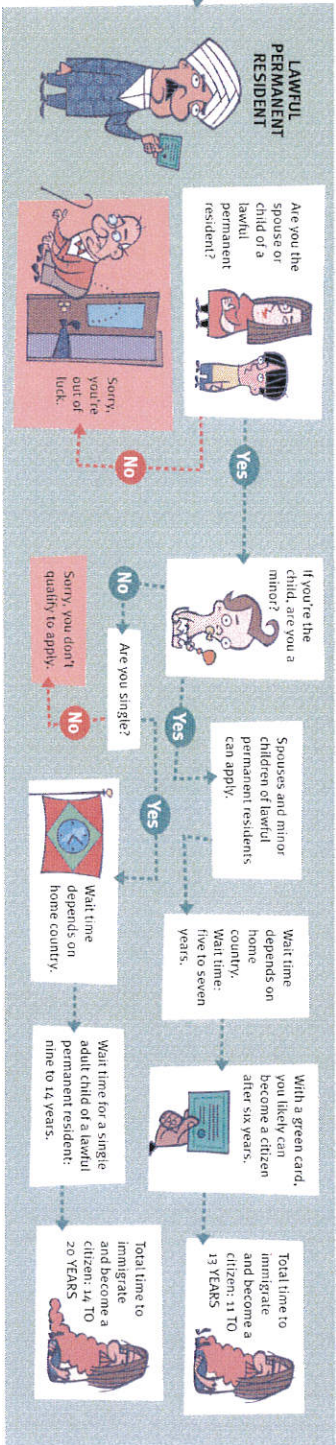
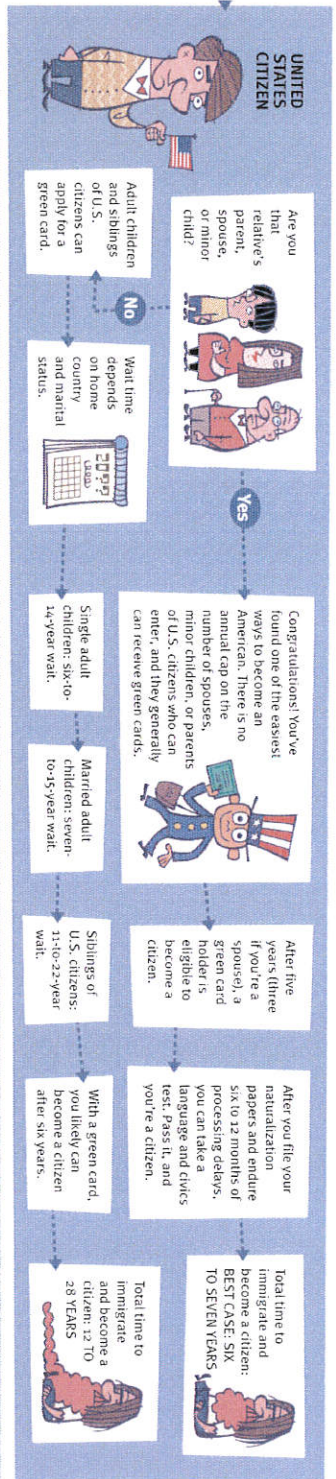


What Part of Legal Immigration Don't You Understand?
